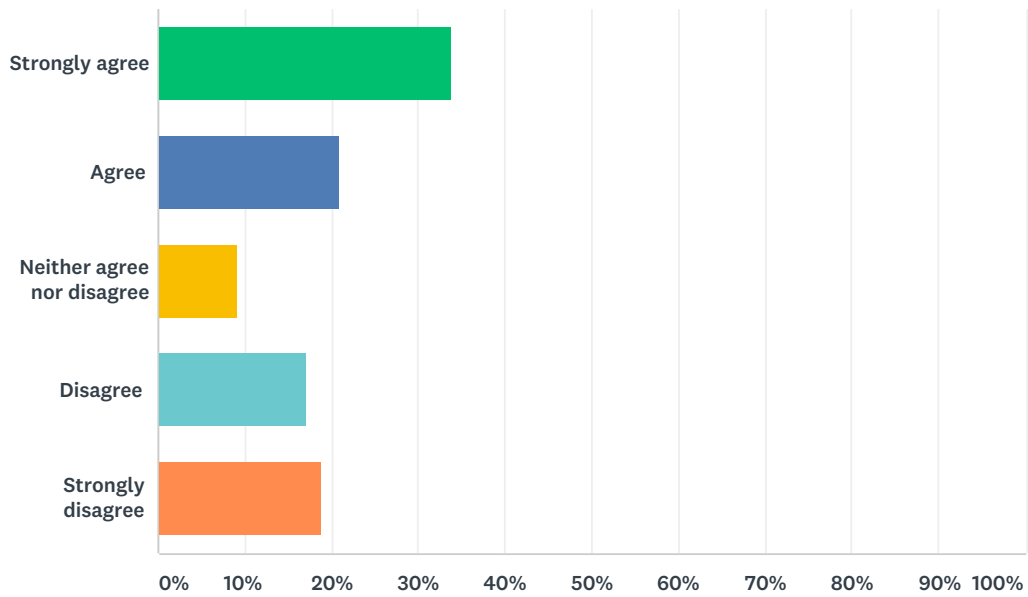


Q1 Do you think we should remove the one month empty property exemption?

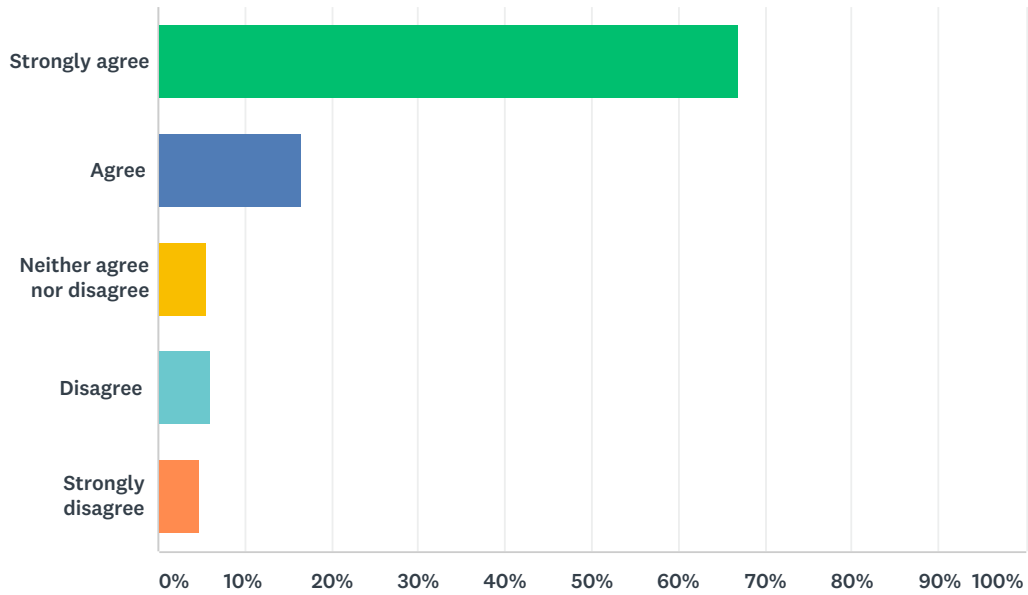

Q2 Do you think we should apply a 200% charge to the owner when their property has remained empty for more than 2 years?

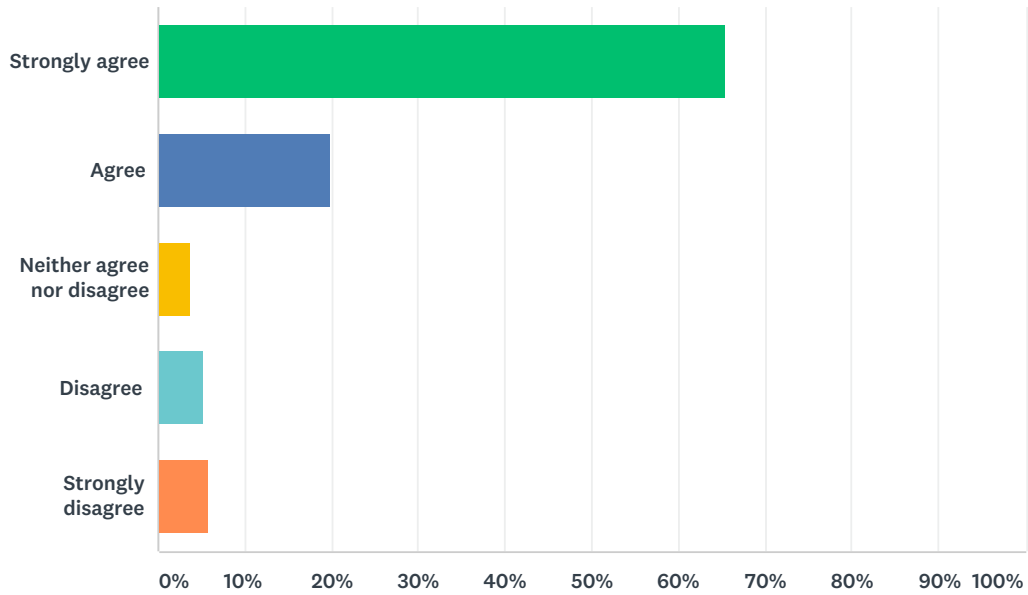

Q3 Do you think we should remove the 10% discount that is applied to second homes within Blaby District?

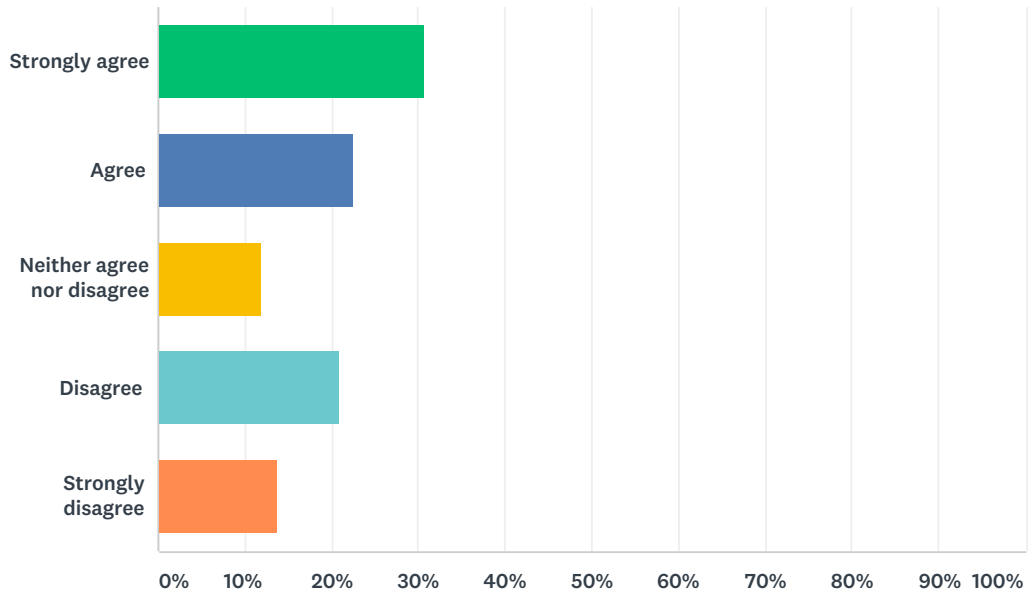

Q4 Do you think we should remove the 12 month 50% discount that is applied to properties undergoing structural alteration or major repairs?

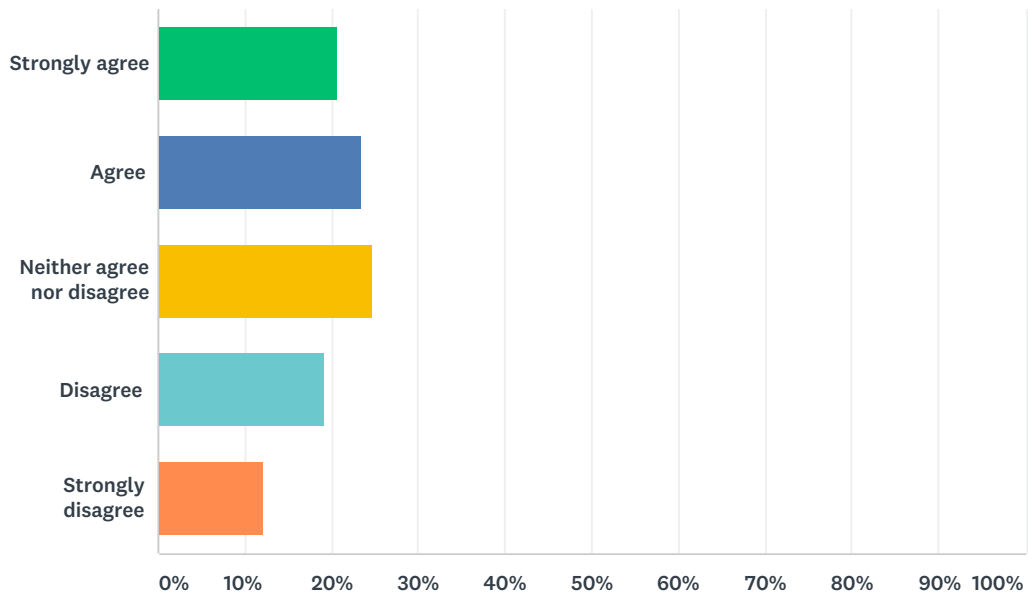

Q5 Do you think that the council should keep the current Council Tax Support scheme unchanged?

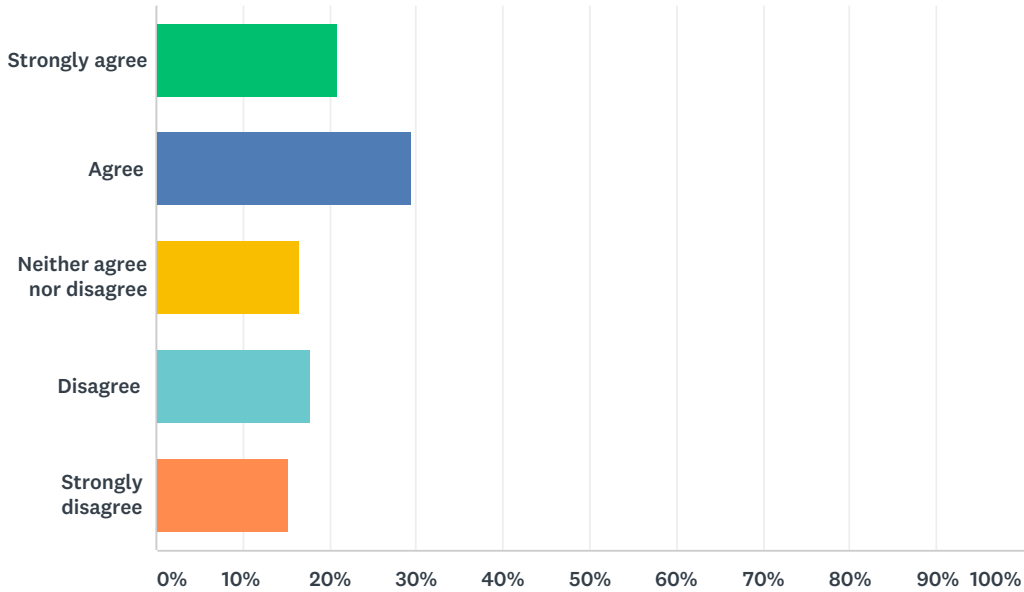

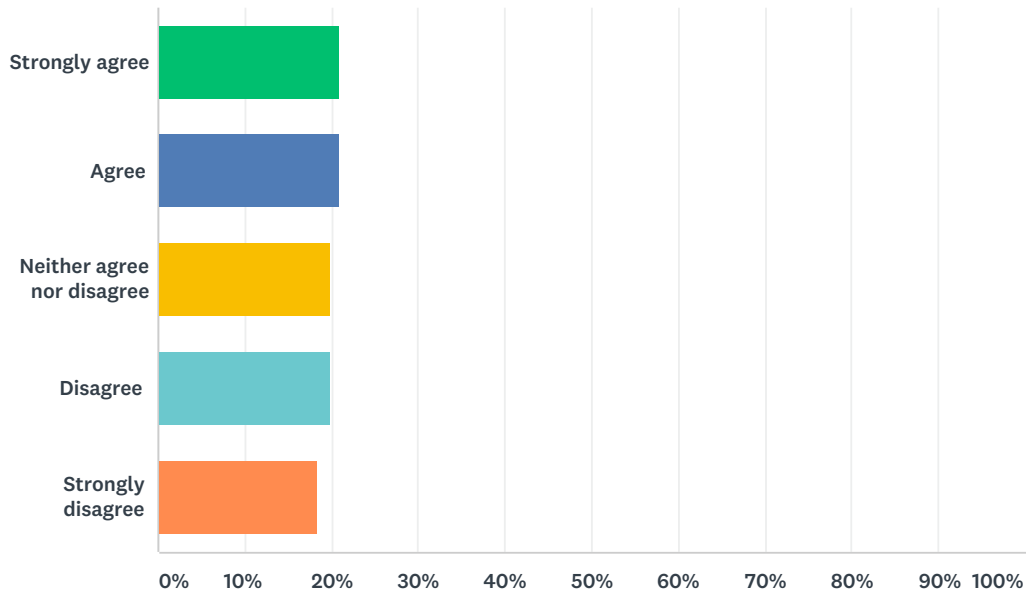

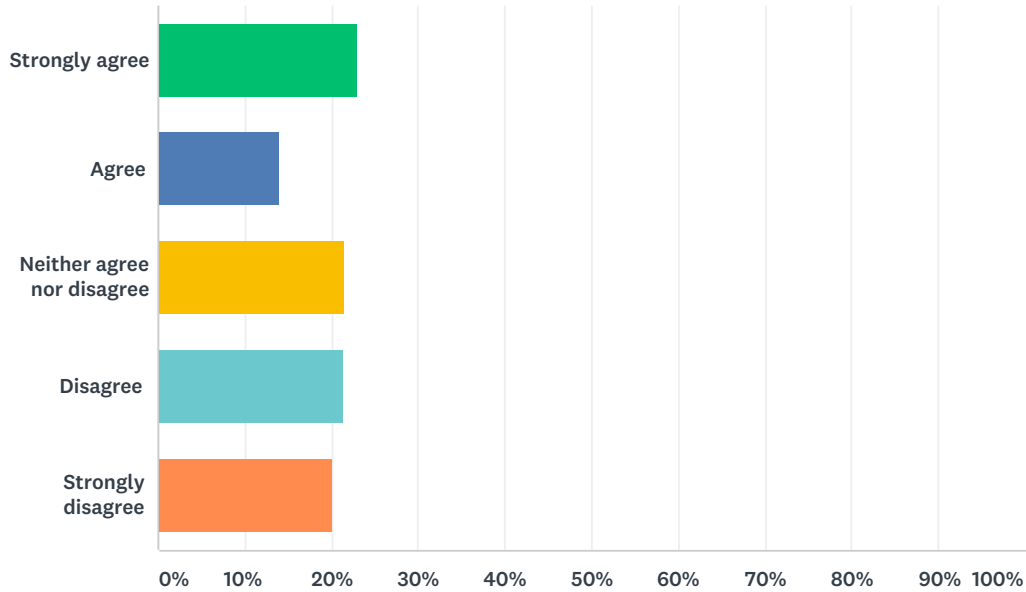

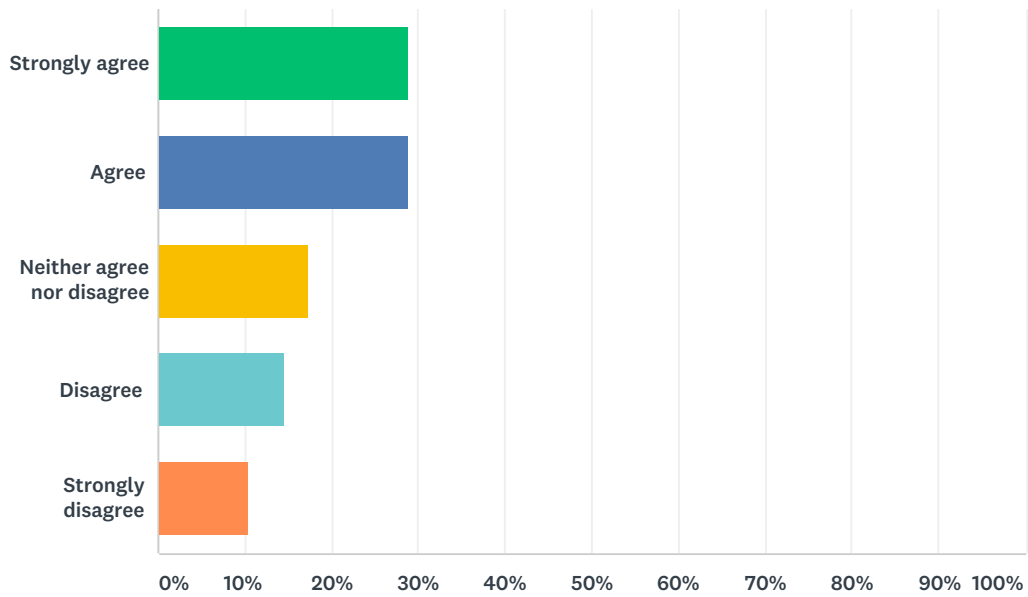

Q9 Do you think that we should treat a self employed person as being in receipt of a minimum wage after they have been trading for 12 months?

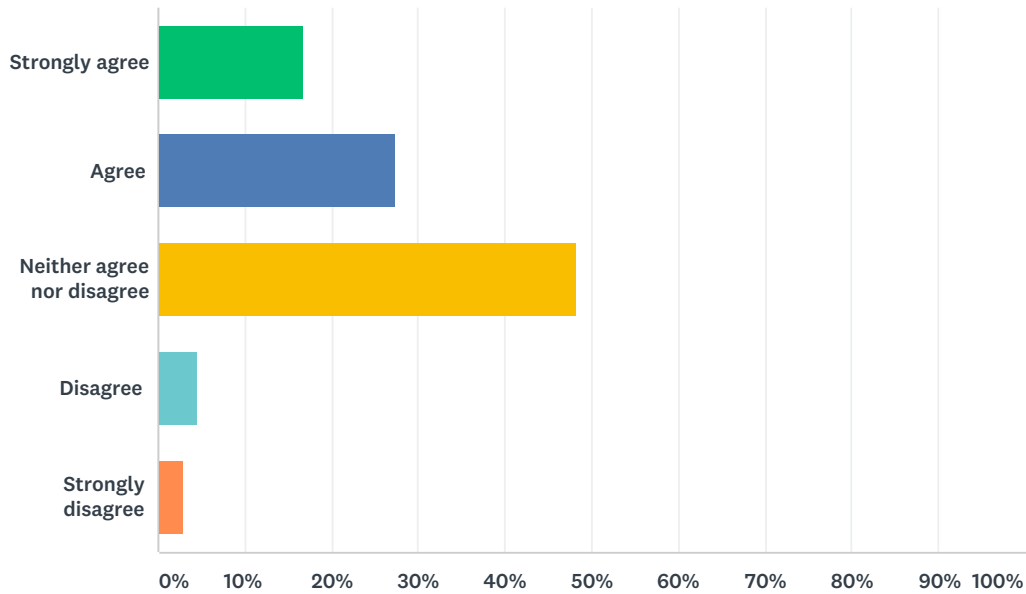

Q10 Do you think we should align our CTS scheme with current Housing Benefit Regulations as outlined in pages 7, 8 and 9 of the consultation document?

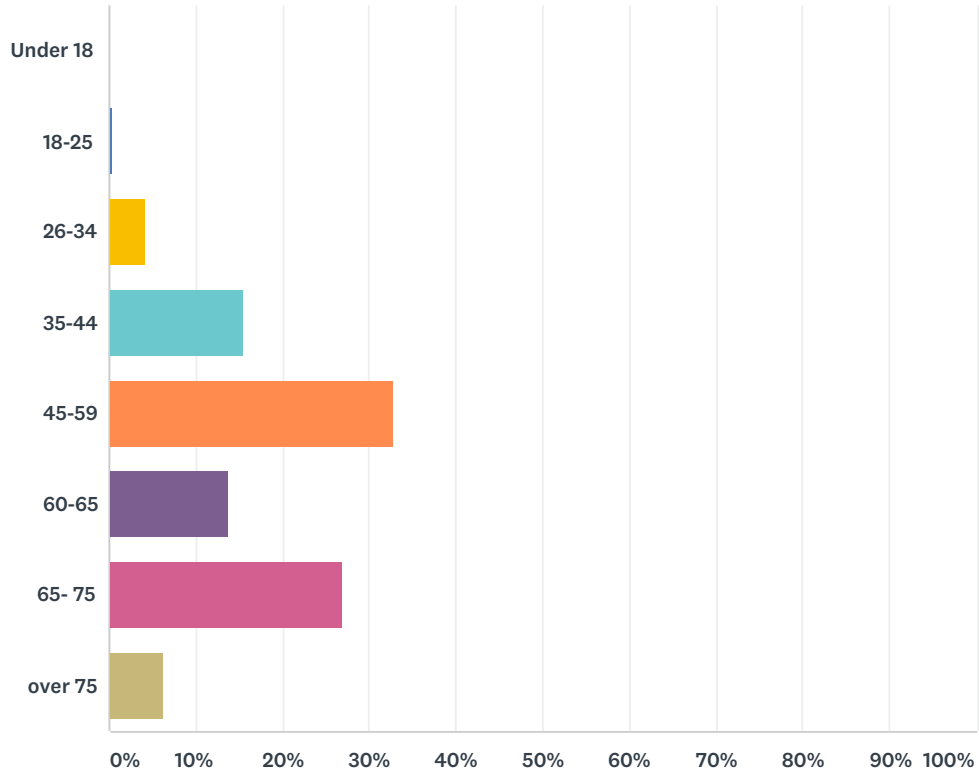

Q14 Please tell us your age group

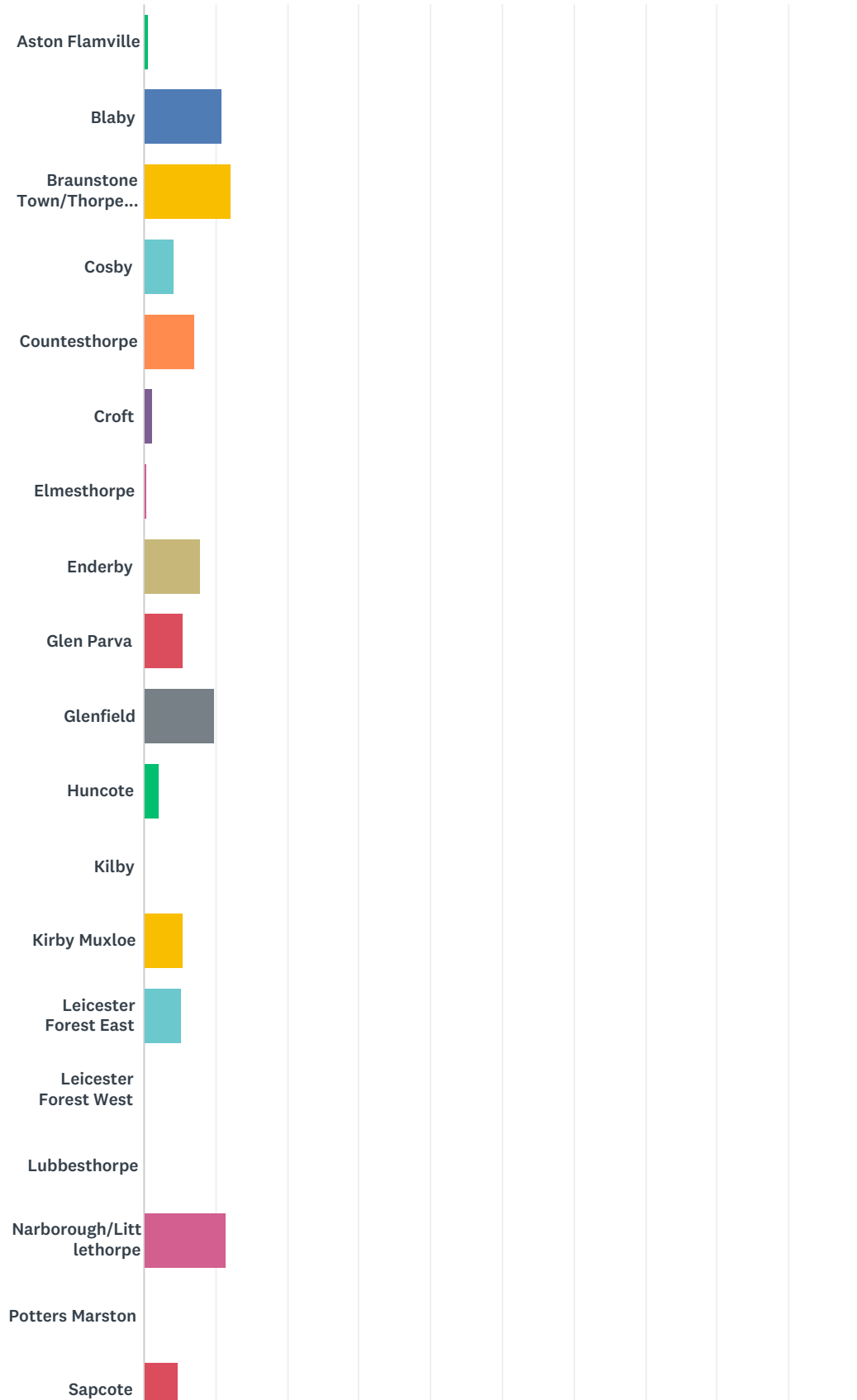

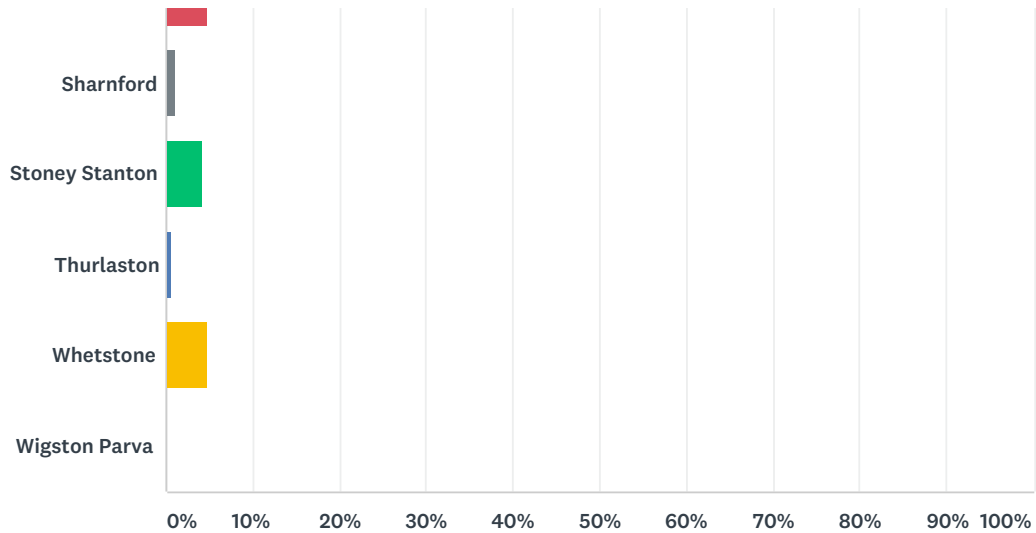
