

## **ARTICLE 7 - THE CABINET EXECUTIVE**

### **7.1 ROLE**

The Cabinet Executive will consist of the Executive Leader, together with at least 2, but not more than 9 councillors, appointed to the Cabinet Executive, by the executive Leader.

The Cabinet Executive will carry out all of the local authority's functions which are not the responsibility of any other part of the local authority, whether by law or under this Constitution.

The Cabinet Executive and its members have wide ranging leadership roles, including:-

- Leading the preparation of the Council's Policies and Budget
- Taking in-year decisions on resources and priorities and delivering and implementing the budget and policies decided by full Council
- Being the focus for forming partnerships with other public, private, voluntary and community sector organisations to address local needs
- Monitoring performance

### **7.2 PROCEEDINGS OF THE CABINET EXECUTIVE**

Proceedings of the Cabinet Executive shall take place in accordance with the Cabinet Executive Procedure Rules set out in Part 4 of this Constitution.

### **7.3 RESPONSIBILITY FOR FUNCTIONS**

The Leader will maintain a list in Part 3 of this Constitution (made available to the Proper Officer detailing any changes within 2 working days), setting out which individual Members of the Cabinet Executive, Committees of the Cabinet Executive, Officers or joint arrangements are responsible for the exercise of particular Cabinet Executive functions.
