Check list

1. All questions answered
2. 1:2500 scale plan attached and marked to show existing route and route of proposed diversion, together with directional information, lengths and grid references. Please note that the usual convention for a diversion order plan is that fulfils the following:
 - a. It is of a scale of 1:2,500 or greater.
 - b. The scale is written on the plan.
 - c. It has a clearly visible title
 - d. It shows the route of the footpath to be closed/stopped up as a bold black line
 - e. It shows the route of the new alternative footpath with bold black dashes
 - f. The lines described A-B-C etc in the written order and the lines on the plan should accord.
 - g. There is a clear key which explains the routes to be closed and their replacements.
 - h. Grid Reference numbers are written on the plan next to each point or Grid References can be read off the plan with the use of labelled Grid lines
 - i. There is a north arrow.
 - j. The routes of the rights of way are accurately plotted.
 - k. There is an O.S. copyright.
