**Blaby District Council (Enderby Road & Johns Court Car Park) (2 hours free parking II) Experimental Order 2019**

NOTICE is hereby given that Blaby District Council (“the Council”) made the above named Experimental Order on the 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2019 under the relevant provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which comes into force on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019 for a period not exceeding 18 months. The effect of the Order will be to change a provision of The District of Blaby (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 by:

- Removing the 30p charge for 2 hours parking in the above named car park and providing 2 hours free parking.

The documents can also be viewed at the Council Offices, Desford Road, Narborough, Leicestershire, LE19 2EP (Monday, Tuesday and Thursday 8:45-5:15, Wednesday 9:30-5:15 and Friday 8:45- 4:45).

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the Experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Any person wishing to object to such indefinite continuation of the provisions may within a period of six months from 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019, (or if this Order is varied by another Order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the Act, six months from the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force) object in writing stating the grounds on which that objection is being made. Objections should be sent to the Leisure & Regulatory Services Group Manager, Blaby District Council, Council Offices, Desford Road, Narborough, Leicestershire, LE19 2EP, or by e-mail to [parking@blaby.gov.uk](mailto:parking@blaby.gov.uk) no later than 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2020.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Experimental Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.

Blaby District Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") as amended and of all other enabling powers and in accordance with Regulation 22 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Blaby District Council (Enderby Road & Johns Court Car Park) (2 hours free parking II) Experimental Order 2019 and shall come into force on the 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2019.
2. The Councils Director or any person authorised by him is authorised to modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it in accordance with the provisions of section 10(2) of the Act.
3. The District of Blaby (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019 is amended as follows:

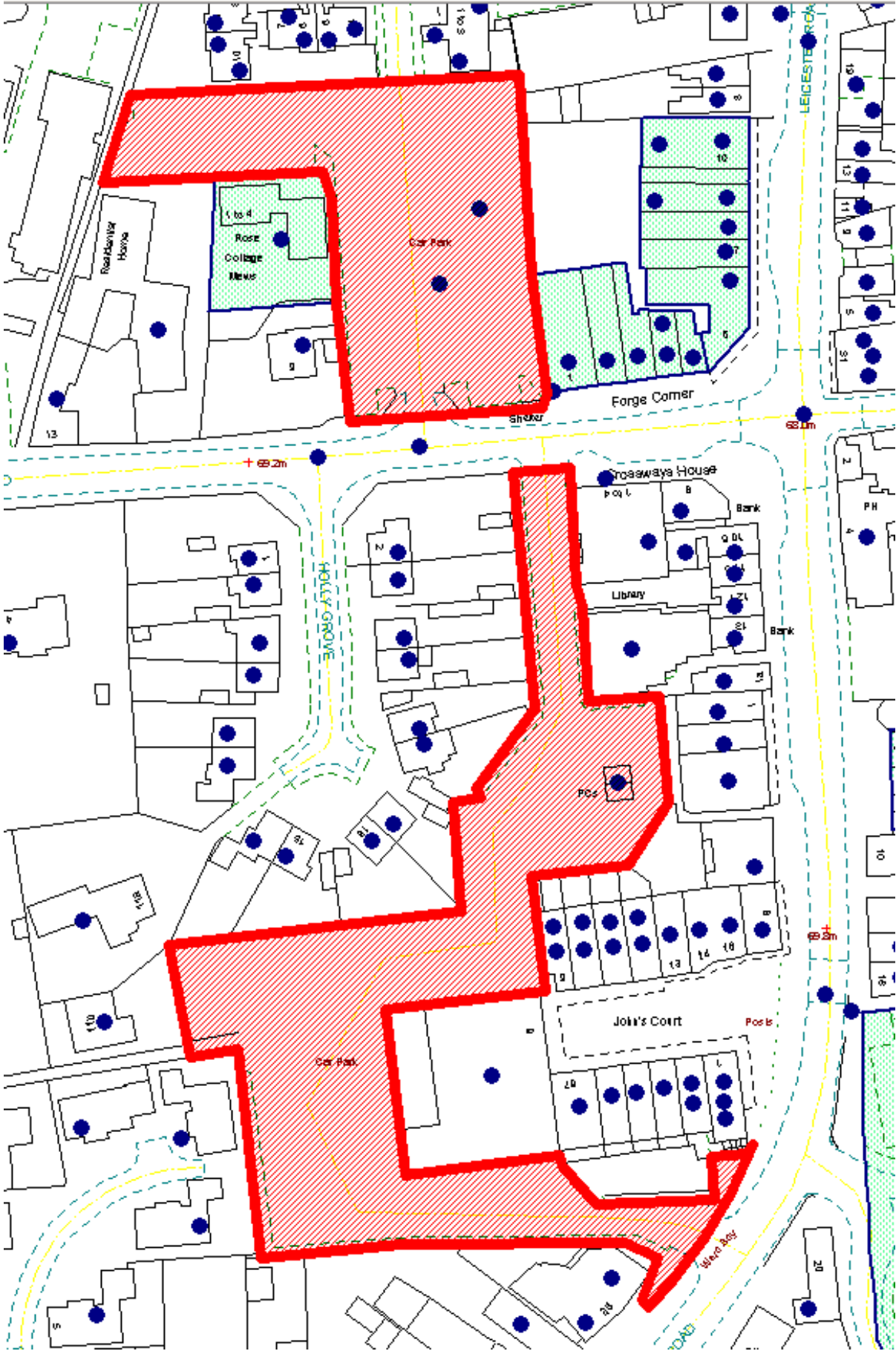
