**Blaby District Council (Narborough Station Ticket Office Car Park)  
Experimental Order 2023**

NOTICE is hereby given that Blaby District Council ("the Council") made the above named Experimental Order on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2023 under the relevant provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended which comes into force on **Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2023** for a period not exceeding 18 months. The effect of the Order will be to change a provision of The District of Blaby (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2022 by:

- Including the Ticket Office Car Park on the opposite side of the railway track at Narborough Train Station and introducing suitable car parking restrictions.

The documents can also be viewed (by appointment only) at the Council Offices, Desford Road, Narborough, Leicestershire, LE19 2EP (Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday 09:00-17:00, Wednesday 09:30-17:00, and Friday 09:00-16:30).

The Council will be considering in due course whether the provisions of the Experimental Order should be continued in force indefinitely. Any person wishing to object to such indefinite continuation of the provisions may within a period of six months from Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2023, (or if this Order is varied by another Order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the Act, six months from the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force) object in writing stating the grounds on which that objection is being made. Objections should be sent to the Environmental Health, Housing & Community Services Group Manager, Blaby District Council, Council Offices, Desford Road, Narborough, Leicestershire, LE19 2EP, or by e-mail to [parking@blaby.gov.uk](mailto:parking@blaby.gov.uk) no later than six months after Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2023.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Experimental Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirements of the Act or of any instrument made under it have not been complied with may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for that purpose.

**STATEMENT OF REASONS**

The proposed changes are being implemented to include the smaller Ticket Office car park within the Council's car parking Order. The restrictions will allow more effective management and prevent misuse of the car park, in the interest of the Council's legal obligations. The temporary changes will be undertaken on an experimental basis for a maximum of 18 months. Impact of these changes will be monitored and assessed during this period and findings shared with key partners.

Blaby District Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) as amended and of all other enabling powers and in accordance with Regulation 22 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 hereby makes the following Order:

1. Blaby District Council (Narborough Station Ticket Office Car Park) Experimental Order 2023 and shall come into force on Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2023.
2. The Council’s Environmental Health, Housing & Community Services Group Manager is authorised to modify or suspend the operation of this Order or any provision of it in accordance with the provisions of section 10(2) of the Act.
3. The District of Blaby (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2022 is amended as follows:
